In 1995 he broke Lou Gehrig's record for consecutive games played, and he voluntarily ended the streak in 1998 after playing 2,632 consecutive games.

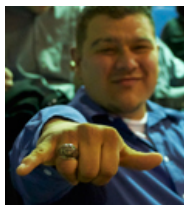
